Private Clinic

he Private Clinic is one of Sydney's most trusted and reputable pregnancy termination clinics. The clinic has a staff of specially trained doctors and nurses who provide family planning advice, contraceptive services and perform termination of pregnancy under intravenous anaesthetic.

The clinic staff aim to provide the best medical care in a comfortable and caring setting.

They are all experienced professionals who are fully sympathetic to your anxieties and difficulties.

PREPARATION FOR YOUR OPERATION

You must have NOTHING to eat or drink (including water, chewing gum and lollies) for six hours prior to your appointment time.

If you are taking any medication, have had a recent cold or flu, have diabetes, high blood-pressure, epilepsy or any other medical condition, please inform the staff when making your booking. You may require a specially scheduled appointment and the doctor may need to give you specific instructions.

PLEASE BRING THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WITH YOU

- A letter from your doctor if possible although it is not essential.
- Your blood group card if you have one. If not, your blood group will be tested during your visit.
- Your Medicare card
- Some sanitary pads (not tampons), an extra pair of underpants and socks to keep your feet warm after the procedure.
- Cash, debit or credit card for payment of fee.

It is a good idea to have someone accompany you but we do ask that you try to limit your support to one or two people. Please do not bring babies or young children to the clinic.

You must not drive yourself to or from the clinic.

ON ARRIVAL AT THE CLINIC

Our receptionist will take your personal details and you will then have counselling and consultations with the doctor performing the procedure and the doctor who will be administering the intravenous anaesthetic. All of your questions will be answered and your medical history and contraception will be reviewed by the doctors.

Before your procedure, a nurse will show you where to safely store your personal items and some simple medical observations will be recorded (pulse rate, blood pressure etc).

At the clinic we perform an ultrasound before your procedure. This is usually done whilst you are under anaesthetic and allows us to confirm the exact stage of your pregnancy and to look for any other problems. (The doctor also uses the ultrasound at the completion of the procedure as a final check).

ANAESTHETIC

Many women are anxious about experiencing pain during their operation. This is a common fear that we fully appreciate and we undertake to ensure that your visit is as stress free and pain free as possible. We find that intravenous anaesthetic relieves women of the worry of experiencing pain or having memories of the procedure.

AFTER YOUR OPERATION

After your procedure you will spend some time in the recovery area under observation by a nurse. When you have sufficiently recovered you will be given light refreshments.

Your visit to the clinic will last approximately three hours although the procedure itself normally takes five to ten minutes.

Before you leave the clinic you will receive a prescription for antibiotics, the contraceptive pill, (if required) and a sheet of post-operative instructions. Please read these instructions carefully, as the information is important. For the safety of yourself and others you must not drive until the day after your procedure.

CONTRACEPTION

The doctor will discuss your future contraception at the time of your consultation. Most types of contraception are available at the clinic and we will be happy to provide you with any information that you require. You may elect to have an I.U.D. fitted at the time of your procedure, however we require that your GP arranges a few tests beforehand to make sure that an I.U.D. is suitable for you. Please call the clinic for details.

COUNTRY PATIENTS

The Private Clinic is a short walk from the Country Train terminal at Central. We can recommend reasonably priced accommodation in our area for those who may need to stay overnight.
